

## Friends of Van Cortlandt Park: Garden 2 Market Internship 2018 Season July 5<sup>th</sup> – October 31<sup>st</sup>



Thanks for your interest in our internship. In addition to helping our community eat healthier through offering more fresh fruits and vegetables at a farm stand, interns will learn about the entire food system (growing, selling, consuming, and composting). This is important because when we understand where our food comes from, and where it goes, we are able to make better decisions about what we buy and eat!

**DETAILS: Interns, will work 3 days per week during the summer and 1 day per week from September to October.** Hired interns are expected to be able to work all 3 days during the summer and through the fall, hours will be altered to fit school schedules.

### **Tuesday Mornings, 10am-1pm *Summer only***

Composting and gardening at the FVCP Compost Site/Garden located inside the park at Mosholu Ave and Broadway (by the Horse Stables). This portion of the program gives interns first hand experience growing food and giving back to their community as the vegetables and herbs grown will be donated to local food pantries. Interns will be responsible for weeding, watering, and maintaining the vegetable beds each week.

### **Wednesday Afternoons, 1:00 P M – 8 PM *Summer and after school September and October***

Running the market, an outdoor farm stand at Amalgamated Housing selling local fruits and vegetables. Interns will learn about food justice issues as well as the basics of running a farm stand: merchandising, customer service, and how to promote the stand in the community. The Amalgamated market will also include youth led weekly cooking demonstrations. Interns will meet and leave from the Friends of Van Cortlandt Park's office at 80 Van Cortlandt Park South.

### **Thursday Mornings, 10-2 PM *Summer only***

This day will be used for trips to other local gardens, ordering produce for our market, keeping the financial records for the market, and exploring aspects of the food system.

There also might be an occasional Saturday trip.

**This internship is physically demanding and runs outside through all weather conditions** from July through October. It can be a rewarding experience for interns as they gain first hand experience of how their food grows in a local urban setting. No experience is needed. All interns under 18 years old must have working papers. Interns will be paid minimum wage for approximately 15 hours per week during the summer and 3-5 hours during the fall.
