

Arts in the Park Adventure

Summer Art Classes

July 13th - August 6th, 2015
in Van Cortlandt Park

This is a group of art classes for *children between the ages of 7-10*. There are *eight classes held on Monday and Thursday between 1-3 PM. The first class is July 13th and the last class is August 6th*. We will hold the class at the round tables behind *Woodlawn Playground (Van Cortlandt Park East just south of Kepler Avenue)*; tents are available for rainy weather. All art supplies are included in the cost.

The art classes will be incorporated with the beautiful scenery and ecology of the park with the Friends of Van Cortlandt Park sharing their knowledge of the park with the class. The art teacher is Valerie Skakun, an accomplished and recognized artist trained in the best art schools in America. She and her assistant, John, will teach interesting and different methods of creating art through the use of varied materials such as linoleum prints, 3-D found sculpture, paper making, tie dying, cyanotype printing and, of course, drawing and painting. At the end of the classes we will have a picnic in the park and display the work that has been created by our talented students. Our hope is to introduce new approaches and deepen the skills of these young artists as they increase their capability to express themselves through the different mediums that create artwork.

*The cost is \$80.00 for each student if you register by June 30th.
Should you register after July 1st the cost will be \$100.00.*

Class is limited to 12 students. Registration on a first pay, first served basis.
