Japanese Honeysuckle

Lonicera japonica

Description: evergreen, woody, twining vine. Ovate-shaped leaves are opposite, roughly 1.5-3" long. Stems are usually 80-120' long. Flowers are fragrant, white tubular flowers that fade to yellow. Fruit are small shiny globular berries that turn from green to black as they ripen. Each fruit contains 2-3 small brown to black ovate seeds.

Wanted for: invading a wide variety of habitats including forest floors, canopies, roadsides, wetlands, and disturbed areas. Girdling small saplings by twining around them, and forming dense mats in the canopies of trees, shading everything below.
