

Cereal Box Backpack

Materials:

- Cereal box
- Ribbon or duct tape
- Glue, tape
- Scissors
- Decorations: markers, crayons, stickers, colorful papers, glitter

Instructions:

Step 1: Tape or glue the bottom of the cereal box closed.



Step 2: If using ribbon for straps cut four slits in the back of the box, two on the top and two towards the bottom, wide enough to stick ribbon through. Cut two strips of ribbon long enough to use as straps, insert and tape into slits.

-OR-

If using duct tape for straps create two strips of double sided duct tape (sticky sides in) and attach through slits in box as above.



Step 3: The top flaps of the box can be cut off to create an open bag, or left in place to close the bag.

Step 4: Time to decorate. Your box probably needs to be covered with paper to allow you to draw on it. You can also cover the entire box with duct tape which will make it very strong.

Once dry you can use this for nature collections, storing the binoculars you made and lots of other games. Have fun!
